whereof I the said Doctor Econowd the Testator have to this my last Will and
Testament set my hand seal the day of in the Year of Our Lord a
One thousand eight hundred and ten" and is thus subscribed "Clara Towneend" and
the Deponent deposing under notice and observing the Blanks for the day and month in
the said year One thousand eight hundred and ten in the said written date of the
said Will the further maid Oath that the said Will was at the time of the death
of the said deceased in a pocket Book belonging to the said deceased in writing the
said deceased a few days before his death told her the Deponent that she would find
the same and where she then found the same accordingly and she also further made
Oath that she had scarce since the death of the said deceased amongst all
the papers of Account and Court and in all places in writing it was likely that
any other Will of the deceased if he had made any would never been deposited
